**ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN BASED ON THE FEEDBACK FROM ALUMNI
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR (2023-2024)**

Assessment and response conducted following the feedback provided by alumni for the academic year (2023-2024)

Alumni Feedback Report 2023-24:-

1. Alumni from B.COM and M.COM programs (2014-2021) participated in the feedback, representing a broad timeframe and academic spectrum.
2. Most respondents expressed satisfaction with the college's efforts to maintain connections with its alumni network.
3. Opinions are divided regarding the CBCS curriculum's ability to bridge the gap between industry and academia, indicating room for improvement.
4. Alumni generally appreciate the life and knowledge skills gained through the CBCS curriculum but have mixed views on its contribution to employability.
5. There are concerns about the practical applicability of skills taught under the CBCS system, with suggestions for enhancement.
6. Some respondents question whether the CBCS curriculum prepares students adequately for national-level competitive exams.
7. Views are mixed on how the CBCS examination pattern impacts student performance, indicating inconsistent experiences.
8. Many respondents suggest that the curriculum should be updated more frequently to align with industry standards and current trends.
9. Alumni are willing to contribute through placements, internships, and guest lectures, showcasing strong engagement and support.
10. Alumni emphasize the need for stronger ties between academia and industry to enhance practical exposure and competitive readiness.



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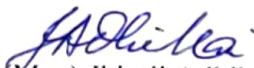
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Based on the aforementioned observations, the following recommendations have been proposed for implementation in the upcoming academic year:

1. Incorporate more industry-relevant practical sessions, case studies, and workshops to strengthen application skills.
2. Ensure frequent updates to the curriculum to reflect current industry trends and technological advancements.
3. Develop structured programs involving alumni to facilitate internships, mentorship, and job placement opportunities.
4. Introduce specialized training modules to better prepare students for national-level competitive exams.

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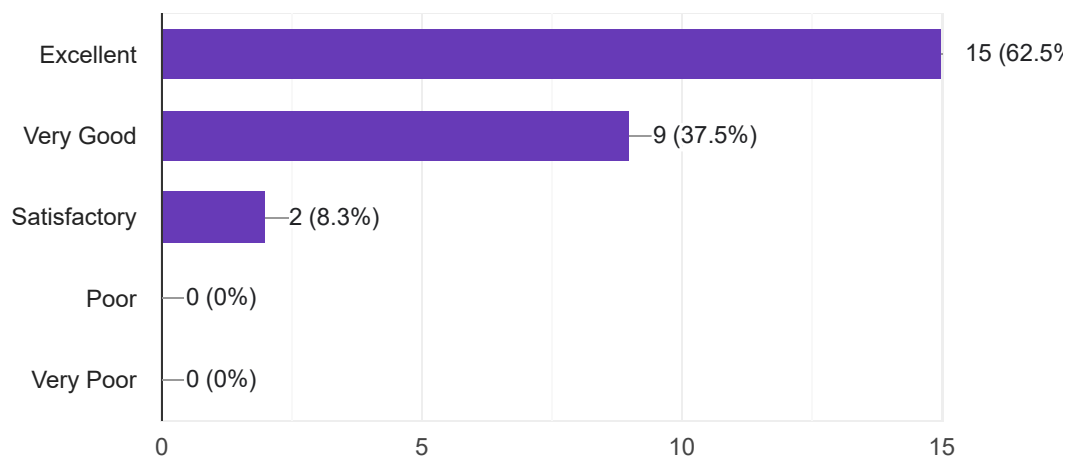

Do you feel there was need to change the syllabus from semester system to choice based credit system?

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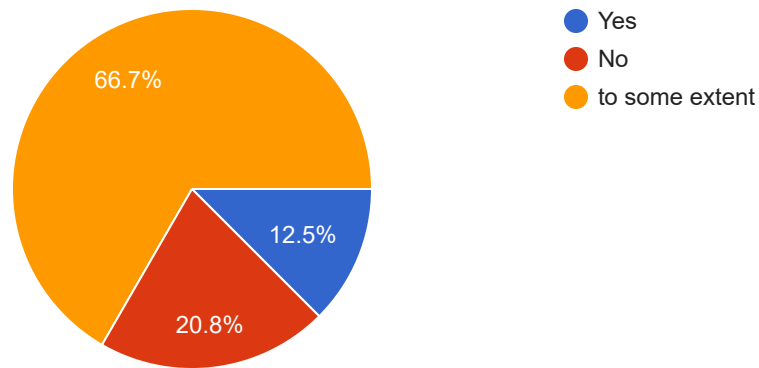
