Workshop on Process to Progress: Building Progressive HEIs Through SOPs



Research and Development Cell of Narayan Zantye College of Commerce has organised a Lecture session "Mangroves and Saltpan Ecosystems" association with the Directorate of Higher Education on Saturday, 1st February, 2025. The session was a part of "Vidnyan Dhara, 2025", a mega science series programme in educational Institutions by DHE and the Goa State Higher Education Council. The session aimed to highlight the ecological importance of the unique ecosystems and their role in coastal sustainability. The resource person of the workshop was Dr. Bhakti B. Salgaokar, Asst. Prof. of Microbiology, Goa University.

Mangroves and Saltpan Ecosystems

At the outset, the Chairperson, Research and Development Cell of the College, Prof. (Dr.) Jhimli Adhikari welcomed and introduced the speaker, and this was followed by the address of the Principal, Prof. (Dr.) Rajendra Kumbharjuvenkar.

Dr. Bhakti provided in-depth knowledge on Mangrove Ecosystems: Their role in coastal protection and biodiversity conservation. The speaker emphasised the threats and conservation: Impact of urbanisation, pollution, and climate change on these ecosystems, along with conservation efforts needed to protect them.

The session was interactive, with students actively participating in discussions. Many raised concerns about habitat destruction and sustainable management practices. The overall session was very fruitful.
