FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR (2023-2024)**

Teachers Feedback on CBCS 2023-24

1. Most teachers agreed on the need to transition from the semester system to the CBCS system.
2. The revised curriculum aims to bridge the gap between industry requirements and academic learning.
3. Regular updates to the curriculum are necessary to keep it relevant and effective.
4. The current syllabus emphasizes knowledge skills, life skills, employability, and application skills.
5. The updated curriculum is expected to enhance the quality of undergraduate education at Goa University.
6. The CBCS system offers students the flexibility to choose their subjects according to their interests.
7. The curriculum is well-suited to help Goa University students compete at the national level.
8. The CBCS examination pattern is likely to positively influence student performance during assessments.
9. Students following the CBCS system may encounter challenges when participating in national-level competitive exams.
10. Educators are generally satisfied with the CBCS curriculum, though some remain partially satisfied, indicating room for improvement.

Considering the above Observation following actions were suggested to be taken during the next academic year.

1. Educators suggest adding more hands-on and practical sessions to the syllabus to enhance experiential learning and better prepare students for real-world applications.
2. Aligning the curriculum with NEP guidelines is recommended to ensure a more policy-driven approach that meets national educational standards and addresses contemporary academic needs.

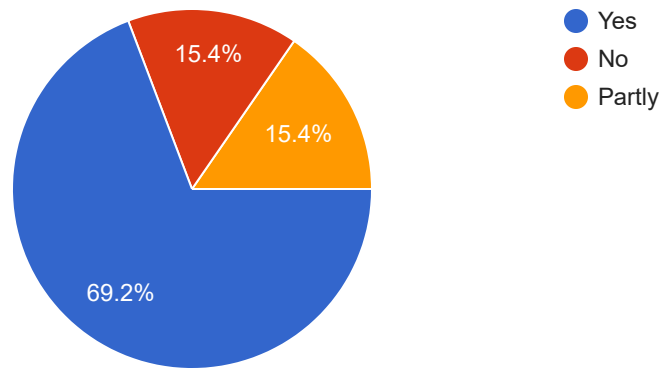

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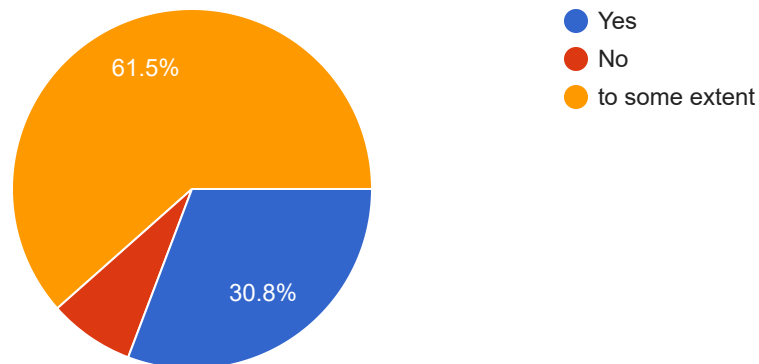

Do you feel that the existing curriculum in CBCS will bridge the gap between industry and academic?

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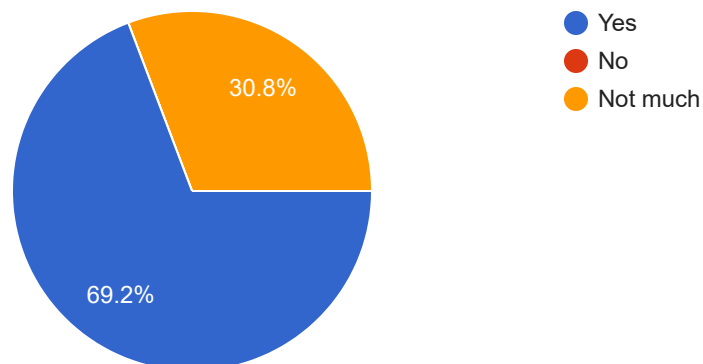

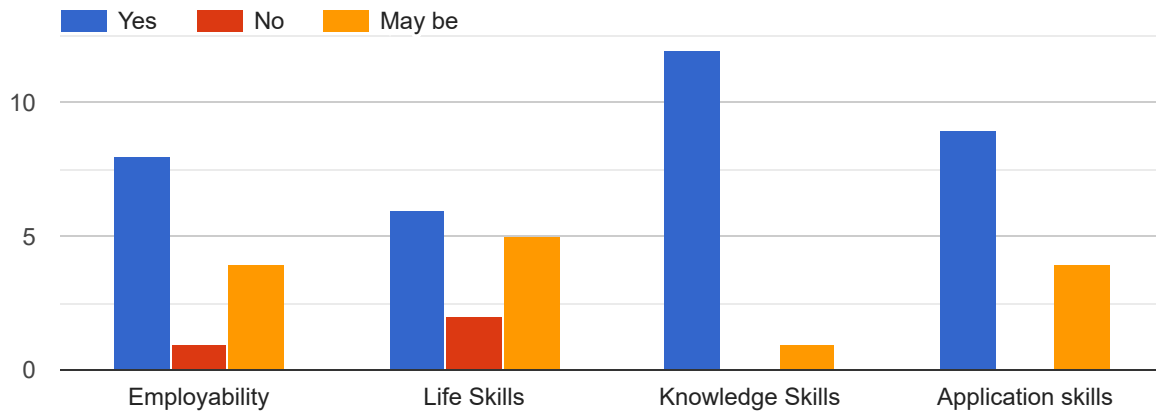

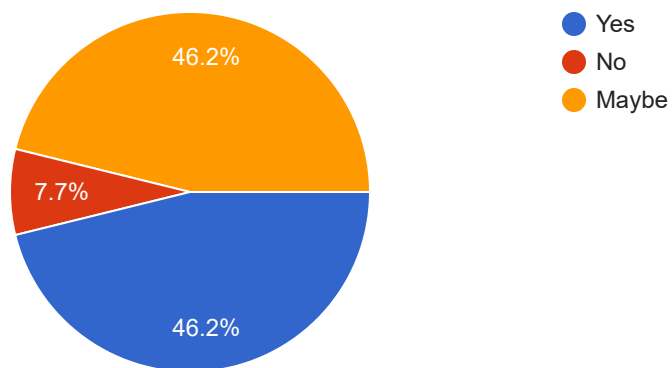

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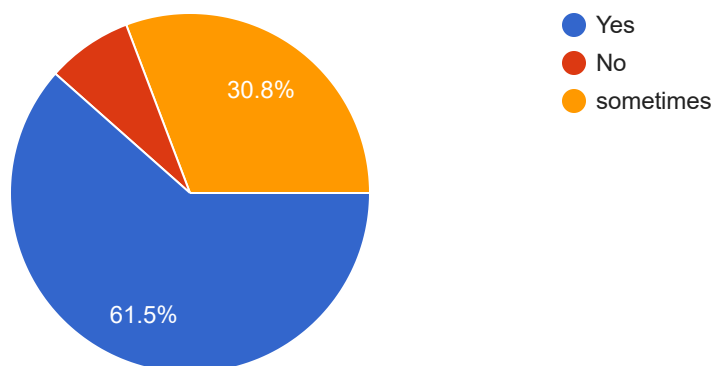

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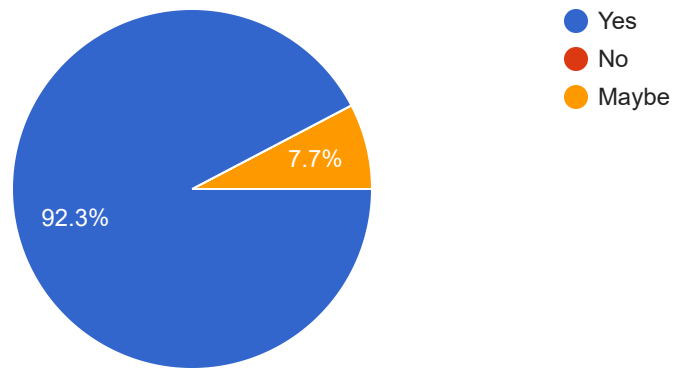

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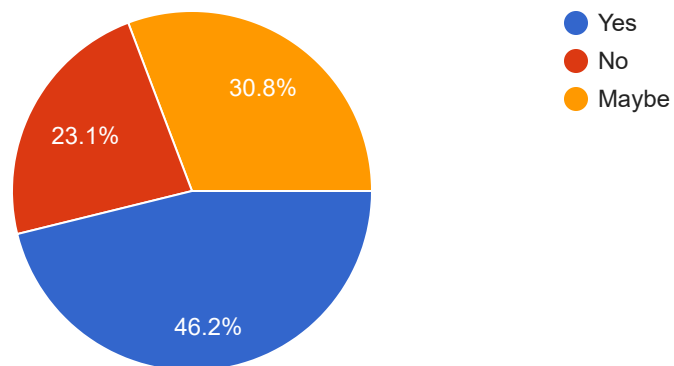

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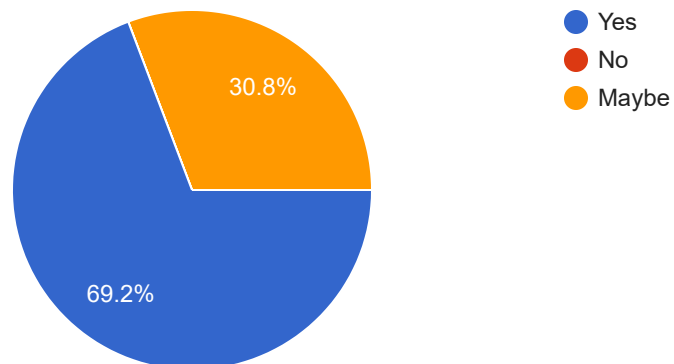

Do you feel that the examination pattern of CBCS will create impact on the performance of student during the examination?

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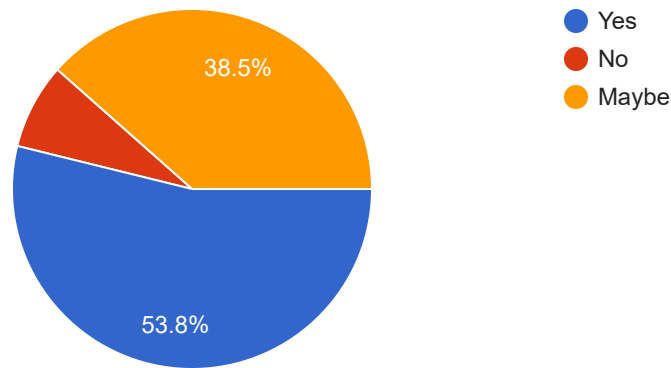

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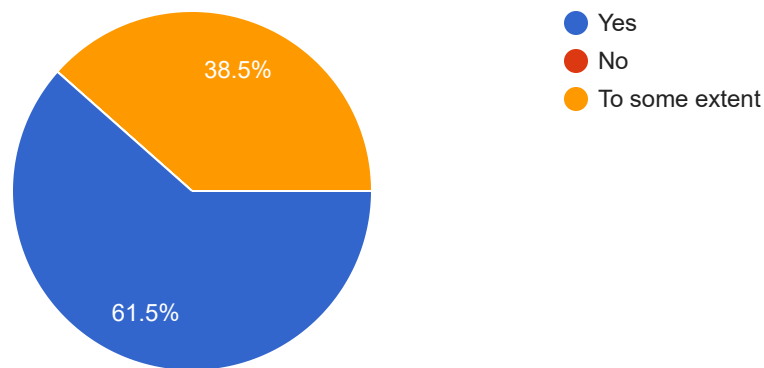
